

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT OUR COOKIE POLICY

GHI GLOBAL ADVISORY PARTNERS AV, S.L. may collect information about the browsing habits of website users through cookies or log files. Cookies will not be used to collect personal information. They will only be installed if the User remains on and continues to browse our website, which implies consent to their use and installation. Below, we provide detailed information about what a cookie is, what it is used for, what types of cookies we use, what their purposes are, and how you can configure or disable them if you wish.

A) WHAT IS A COOKIE AND WHAT IS IT USED FOR?

A "Cookie" is a small file stored on the user's computer, tablet, smartphone or any other device, containing information about their browsing.

The set of "cookies" from all our users helps us to improve the quality of our website, allowing us to monitor which pages are useful, which are not, and which can be improved.

Cookies are essential for the operation of the Internet, providing countless benefits in the provision of interactive services, facilitating navigation and usability of our website.

Cookies cannot damage your device in any way. On the contrary, having them active helps us to identify and resolve errors.

B) WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

ACCORDING TO THE ENTITY THAT MANAGES THEM:

Own cookies: These are cookies sent to your device from our own servers or domains, from which we provide the service you request.

Third-party cookies: These are cookies sent to your device from a server or domain that is not managed by us, but by another collaborating entity, such as those used by Google Analytics. ACCORDING TO THEIR PURPOSE:

Technical cookies: These are those necessary for browsing and the proper functioning of our website. They allow, for example, traffic and data communication to be controlled, access to restricted areas, the purchasing process of an order, the use of security elements, storage of content to be able to broadcast videos or share content through social networks.

Analytics cookies: These allow us to quantify the number of users and thus carry out the measurement and statistical analysis of the use that users make of the services

provided. To do this, their browsing on our website is analysed in order to improve the range of products and services we offer.

ACCORDING TO THEIR STORAGE PERIOD:

Session cookies: These are temporary cookies that remain in the cookies file of your browser until the User leaves the website, so none are recorded on your computer's hard drive. The information obtained through these cookies is used to analyse traffic patterns on the website. In the long run, this allows us to provide a better experience to improve content and facilitate use.

Persistent cookies: These are stored on the hard drive and our website reads them each time the User makes a new visit. A permanent cookie has a specific expiry date. The cookie will stop working after that date. We generally use these cookies to facilitate purchasing and registration services.

PURPOSE OF EACH COOKIE USED:

Below we detail the cookies used on our website and the provider to which they belong. Own cookies are those belonging to our domain and third-party cookies are those belonging to other domains according to the following table:
